

2026 IPC INFORMATION



The **Inspire Performance Collective (IPC)** is an extension opportunity for young dancers, providing a platform for them to be part of a valued performance ensemble. Under the guidance of talented choreographers and mentors, students in the IPC have the chance to develop their dance abilities, confidence, creativity, teamwork, and leadership skills.

The program offers numerous performance opportunities throughout the year including participation in eisteddfod and community performances, plus additional experiences such as social events and excursions, workshops with industry guests, and a Christmas performance.

The aim of the IPC program is to foster a supportive learning and creative community, where students with a passion for the arts and performance can grow in their technique and strength across various genres of Dance, build valuable friendships and connection, and pursue their creative gifts and interests.



Private Tuition + Soloist Opportunities

Further private training opportunities are available for performers desiring more competitive performance experience as a soloist and/or duet capacity. Solo performance work is optional in addition to being a member of an IPC Performance Ensemble. Our talented team provide solo or duet creations across the following genres: Jazz, Hip Hop, Contemporary, Lyrical, Classical Ballet, Tap, Song & Dance, Vocal.

IPC Team Values

Our IPC students are valued team players and public representatives of *Inspire Creative Arts!* This is an exciting role of leadership and commitment. By signing up to IPC, students and families are agreeing to:

- 1/ **Being a dedicated team player** by attending all rehearsals and performances to the best of our ability;
- 2/ **Encouraging and uplifting** our IPC team members with positive words & actions;
- 3/ **Attending all weekly classes** to continue developing our technique, creating amazing performance works for the stage, and building friendship with our teammates;
- 4/ When representing Inspire at public events, **we support everyone that we meet with kind words and actions; we lend a hand where needed and are a role model for younger students; we listen out for teachers' instructions and present well-groomed in the Inspire team uniform and costumes.**

IPC Annual Program Inclusions

IPC Annual Membership includes *at least* the following:

- 1-2 Eisteddfod events per year;
- 1-2 Community events per year;
- IPC Family Showcase (*in-studio: an opportunity for family & friends to view all our performance items before we take to the stage!*)
- All additional group rehearsals,
- Annual Christmas performance;
- An additional performance item in Inspire's whole school end of year concert;
- 'Welcome to IPC' event (Jan/Feb)
- Optional Add-On: Excursion to a local Theatre society show or Cinema outing, Christmas celebration (December), and a Workshop Experience with a Special Guest (November/December).



IPC Membership Pricing

Annual Membership Fee Option 1: pay upfront = \$100 (including GST)

Annual Membership Fee Option 2: pay in termly instalments = \$25.00 per term (including GST)

The IPC membership fee is a one-time payment covering all IPC rehearsals, community event or competition entries, the Christmas Show and fun extras (this is on top of your weekly class tuition fees). Please note that by choosing to pay for the membership fee in termly instalments, you are required to commit to paying all instalments as our IPC budget is set at the start of the year and relies on this commitment.



Additional Costs

- **IPC Team Jersey (billed Feb/March):** This is to wear over the top of your costume at all events, approximately \$60-\$70 (*please note that this is a generic item and can be re-worn each year that it fits!*)
- **IPC Costume/s:** \$60 p/costume (billed Feb/March). Please note that Dance Troupe Members will usually have 2 x costumes billed.
- **Competition Spectator Entry:** Each event charges an admission fee for spectators. Some are cash at the door per person, with other events charging a 'Registration Fee' per dancer instead. This varies between events and more information is provided by the organisers of each event closer to the date.

Please note that we staff every competition, and communicate drop-off and pick-up times so that it is not compulsory for parents to have to stay at each event.

 - 1 x recreational Dance Class (Ballet, Jazz or Lyrical/Contemporary)
- Teen/Senior IPC Dance Troupe
 - Senior IPC Dance Training Block (60 mins)
 - Teen/Senior Contemporary Tumbling Class (45 mins)



Pricing for IPC Training Blocks

In 2026 we will be continuing the 'Training Block' format for our IPC Dance Troupes. Each block will include dedicated time to choreography, technique and strength training. Each age group will either have a 1hr training block. Locate your age group below to view a sample of the term's tuition pricing.
