
ALICIA CLOVER

DRAMA

With classes for ages 6 to 18, our Inspire Drama program is tailored towards the needs of each specific age group.

JUNIOR DRAMA (School Grades 1 - 3)

Our fun intro to acting begins with learning improvisation skills through structured games and exercises. We build characters and tell stories using voice, mime, movement and more! We nurture teamwork skills, creativity and confidence as we create a short piece of theatre from scratch. Students extend their script skills as we perform a comedy play.

PRIMARY / INTERMEDIATE DRAMA (School Grades 4 - 6)

Our Primary students explore comedy, drama, physical theatre, improvisation and devising at an intermediate level. We explore a variety of genres, and work on characterisation as we create original scenes from scratch. Students enjoy furthering their understanding of ensemble work, scripted comedy, and drama as we work on a play.

TEEN DRAMA (School Grades 7 - 8)

We challenge our Teen students to work from a place of truth, and nurture their unique voice and personal stories, as we focus on small-group scenes using scripts from theatre, film and television. We also extend our teamwork skills and have huge amounts of fun with playbuilding, improvisation, mime, voice and comedy work.

SENIOR DRAMA (School Grades 9-12)

Senior students explore comedy, drama, physical theatre, improvisation and devising at an advanced level. Our Senior students work with exciting and sophisticated texts from stage and screen as they hone their script analysis skills. We continue to focus on truthful acting, and learn the essentials of screen acting. Senior actors are also equipped with skills for auditions and castings.



MUSICAL THEATRE

With classes for ages 6 to 18, our Inspire Musical Theatre program provides each age group with specific skills...

JUNIOR MUSICAL THEATRE (School Grades 1-3)

Students are introduced to the world of Musical Theatre and learn to express the stories, themes, and emotions of popular musicals through singing, dancing and acting.

PRIMARY / INTERMEDIATE MUSICAL THEATRE (School Grades 4-6)

We further investigate the themes and characters of a range of new and classic musicals and build on our storytelling skills. Students advance their singing, dancing and acting technique to the next level, and add harmony singing, and theatre jazz dance technique to their list of skills.

TEEN / SENIOR MUSICAL THEATRE (School Grades 7-12)

Senior students tackle music and subject matter of increasing sophistication and are exposed to a range of theatrical choreography styles. Students explore the characters, themes and stories of a variety of new and classic musicals and hone their performance skills and stage presence.
